CAT offers most recent JAA exam questions for IR, CPL and ATPL

Civil Aviation Training Europe (CAT Europe) is now offering the most recent JAA questions (CQB 14) through their Online Trainer, a web-based tool that is available 24/7 to students in pursuit of aeroplane and helicopter pilot licensing.

CAT owner, Hans-Jürgen Seibert, states: „We’re the only training provider to offer this service. Our integrated question database meets the actual Central Question Bank (CQB 14) of the JAA. These questions serve as the confirmed guideline for the exam authorities of the JAA countries. It’s clearly the best way to prepare for the IR, CPL and ATPL exams.“

It is available to future aeroplane and helicopter pilots, as well as to existing pilots wishing to increase their certification or licensing levels, or just improve their knowledgebase.

The Online Trainer simulates the exam interface and therefore offers a very similar test-taking experience to that given by the official authorities. Since it is an online application, an Internet connection and a browser are all that is required to use the program, so the student has access to the exam training at any time, independent of location. Among other things, CAT’s Online Trainer charts the individual learning progress of each student, and even retains information on when training was interrupted, so the student can continue directly from the saved status when they return to the program.

The price of the Online Trainer depends on the respective course, but ranges from 99,- € for an IR to 190,- € for an ATPL package. CAT’s Online Trainer is sold much like a software licence, so it has a fixed duration of access, e.g. 18 months for ATPL access. Extensions are possible.
